		MEDIA, COMM & INFORMATION		MUSIC		COLLEGE OPPORTUNITY FUND \$116 per credit hour per semester The College Opportunity Fund (COF), created by the Colorado legislature, provides a stipend to eligible undergraduates paying in-state tuition. The stipend pays a portion of total tuition for undergraduate students who attend a Colorado public institution or a participating private institution. The stipend is paid to the institution on a per-credit-hour basis, and the credit-hour amount is set annually by the General Assembly. Students must complete the COF application on the official state College Opportunity Fund website and authorize use of funds to receive COF. Students who do not complete both of these steps will be responsible for paying the total in-state tuition.

Rates published by the Bursar's Office are approved by the Board of Regents annually in accordance with the level of cash fund appropriations set for the university by the Colorado General Assembly. The Board of Regents reserves the right to change tuition and fees at any time. Tuition charged is based on residency classification, number of credit hours and your college, school or program. Fractional credit hours outside of flat rate tuition are assessed the average rate between the two closest credit hours. Dual degrees are charged the higher rate. These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. Rates and deadlines may be subject to change.

¹ The student share of tuition is a flat rate between 12 and 18 credit hours. Total tuition continues to increase at the same increment for each hour over 18.

² "Total Fees" do not include the A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee, the Business Career Center Fee and the New Student Fee. 12 credit hours per semester is considered full-time status for undergraduates in general and for financial aid. Graduating in four year averages out to 15–16 credit hours per semester in fall and spring (does not include summers).

CU BOULDER TUITION GUARANTEE

Tuition and fees for undergraduate Colorado resident (in-state) students is guaranteed to be the same rate for four years. colorado.edu/bursar/costs/cu-boulder-tuition-guarantee.

BILLS

Bills are online only. Students access billing information in Buff Portal (buffportal.colorado.edu) once they are enrolled. Parents and other family members must get access from their students in order to view the bill. Students authorize payers in Buff Portal (buffportal.colorado.edu). Authorized payers access billing information in CUBill&Pay. colorado.edu/bursar/billing

All students are required to have health insurance while attending CU Boulder.

Undergraduate students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours must complete the health insurance requirement process by the published deadline. Students must complete this requirement in their first semester and again every fall. Otherwise, the student will be automatically enrolled in the Anthem Gold Student Health Insurance Plan and it will be added to the bill. colorado.edu/health/insurance

PAYMENT PLANS

CU Boulder offers interest-free payment plans to pay the tuition and fee bill month over the course of each semester and summer.

Payment plans divide the university bill into smaller, more manageable monthly installments. Students sign up for payment plans in Buff Portal; authorized payers sign up in CUBill&Pay. colorado.edu/bursar/payments/payment-plans.

DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR TUITION & FEE REFUNDS

Direct deposit allows for quick, secure deposit of refunds from confirmation deposits, housing deposits, scholarships, financial aid, overpayments, etc., into your bank account. Set up direct deposit in Buff Portal (buffportal.colorado.edu). Direct deposit of tuition and fee refunds is unrelated to payroll direct deposit. colorado.edu/bursar/refunds
