These rates apply to Boulder Main Campus only. Classes taken on different campuses and Continuing Education have separate tuition, fees and billing. Rates and deadlines may be subject to change.

OTHER REQUIRED FEES

A&S (ASSET) FEE \$1.32 PER CREDIT HOUR PER SESSION

Applies to all classes in the College of Arts and Sciences regardless of a student's major or program of study.

APPLICATION FEE

One-time nonrefundable application fee
 -New domestic undergraduate students \$50
 -New international undergraduate students \$70

NEW STUDENT FEE

One-time nonrefundable fee upon entering a degree program
 -New undergraduate students and transfers \$232
 -New international undergraduates and transfers \$500

CU Boulder Tuition Guarantee

Tuition for undergraduate nonresident and international students is guaranteed to be the same rate for four calendar years.

Groups A–P: Students first enrolled prior to Spring 2021

Group Q: Students first enrolled in Summer 2021, Fall 2021 or Spring 2022

Group R: Students first enrolled in Summer 2022, Fall 2022 or Spring 2023

Group S: Students first enrolled in Summer 2023, Fall 2023 or Spring 2024

Students first enrolled in Summer 2024 pay Group S rates in Summer 2024 and then move to Group T rates (published in July) starting in Fall 2024.

¹ In summer, nonresident tuition is a flat rate between 14 and 18 credit hours. It continues to increase at the same increment for each hour over 18.

² Fee totals do not include the A&S Tech (ASSET) Fee and the New Student Fee.
